50% percent of the people who walk in your door need other repairs to their vehicle. You may perform some of those tasks or send it to a business partner who has a reciprocal agreement with you.

### **Production & Cycle Time:**

Having every department enter the hand-off dates in the vehicle notes will insure keeping each vehicle on schedule.

#### Safety & Thinking Green:

All technicians are required to be respirator fit tested annually. This includes all techs, not just the painters.

### **Estimation:**

Remember, masking jambs and openings is not included operations. You will not get paid for it every time, but you should ask the insurer.

### Technical:

On many new vehicles with Traction Control features the wheel steering control sensor may need to be calibrated every time the wheels are aligned. This will require a scan tool and a 4WD alignment.

Masking Paper Facts—Did you know that the diameter of the roll is absolutely no indication of roll length? Footage is what is used to mask, not diameter. Diameter is controlled by the machine winding the roll.

## **BEST PRACTICES FOR MASKING —**

- Use the narrowest tape possible for each operation. 1 1/2" is much more cost effective than 2." .
- Use paintable plastic and avoid using unnecessary paper.
- Use liquid masking on wheels and tires to prevent underneath overspray and dust prevention.
- Use foam aperture tape to seal up jams to prevent paint lines and overspray.
